## THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (CEMENT-MANUFACTURE) AMENDMENT NOTICE 1938.

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby give notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Cementmanufacture) Amendment Notice 1938.

2. The industry to which this notice relates is the following :---

Manufacture of cement: Portland and other structural or building cement.

**3.** The notice given by me under the said section 14 bearing date the 4th day of December, 1936, and published in the *Gazette* on the 10th day of December, 1936\* (hereinafter called the principal notice), is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "1st day of December, 1938", the words "but in the industry described as 'Manufacture of cement: Portland and other structural or building cement', the 1st day of January, 1940."

4. The principal notice is further amended by adding thereto the following additional paragraph :—

"Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained in the case of a person being an incorporated company limited by shares which on the date of publication hereof in the *Gazette* was lawfully engaged in carrying on the industry described as 'Manufacture of cement: Portland and other structural or building cement', the date on which this notice shall take effect shall be whichever of the following dates shall first happen, namely:—

"(i) The 1st day of January, 1940; or

"(ii) The fourteenth day after the date upon which notice is given to the company by the Bureau of Industry setting out that in the opinion of the Bureau there has, since the date of publication hereof in the *Gazette*, been a substantial change in the beneficial ownership of the shares of the company, and that the Bureau has determined accordingly that the company shall not carry on without a license."

5. As regards the industry to which this notice relates, except as modified by this notice, the principal notice shall continue in full force and effect.

6. Except as regards the industry to which this notice relates, nothing herein contained shall in any way affect the principal notice.
