**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (FRUIT AND VEGETABLE
CANNING) NOTICE 1940.**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, the Minister of Industries and Commerce doth hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Fruit and Vegetable Canning) Notice 1940.

2. The industry to which this notice relates (hereinafter called the said industry) is the following :—

The canning as hereinafter defined for sale of fruit and vegetables.

3. For the purpose of this notice—

“Canning” means preservation in hermetically sealed cans, jars, or other containers.

The canning of fruit and vegetables shall be deemed not to include the preservation of jams or pickles.

4. From such one of the respective dates specified herein as is applicable to the case, the said industry shall be carried on only pursuant to a license issued under Part III of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, and in conformity with the terms and conditions of such license.

5. The dates hereinbefore referred to shall be the following, namely :—

(a) In the case of persons who on the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette* are engaged in the said industry the said date shall be the 5th day of March, 1940, or such earlier or later date (if any) as may hereafter be specified by a further notice under the said section 14 given before the said 5th day of March, 1940 :

(b) In all other cases the said date shall be the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette*.
