## THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (ASBESTOS CEMENT PRODUCTS MANUFACTURE) AMENDMENT NOTICE 1951

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, the Minister of Industries and Commerce doth hereby give notice as follows :—

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Asbestos Cement Products Manufacture) Amendment Notice 1951.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The notice given by the Minister of Industries and Commerce under section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, dated the 4th day of December, 1936, and published in the *Gazette* on the 10th day of December, 1936,\* is hereby amended by omitting the words "Manufacture of products consisting of a combination of asbestos and cement".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the notice but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

The effect of the amendment made by this notice is that the industry of "the manufacture of products consisting of a combination of asbestos and cement" is no longer required to be licensed under the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936.
