**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (MALT EXTRACT MANUFACTURE)  
REVOCATION NOTICE 1950**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Charles Moore Bowden, Minister of Industries and Commerce, do hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Malt Extract Manufacture) Revocation Notice 1950.

2. This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3. The Industry Licensing (Malt Extract Manufacture) Notice 1939\* and the Industry Licensing (Malt Extract Manufacture) Notice 1939, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.
