## THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (STORAGE-BATTERY MANU-FACTURE) AMENDMENT NOTICE 1938.

Pursuant to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby give notice as follows:—

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Storagebattery Manufacture) Amendment Notice 1938.
  - 2. The industry to which this notice relates is the following:—

The manufacture and/or assembly of secondary or storage cells and batteries, commonly known as wet batteries, or any part or parts thereof.

- 3. The notice heretofore given by me under the said section in respect of the aforesaid industry and cited as the Industry Licensing (Storage-battery Manufacture) Notice 1938\* is amended by substituting for the words "1st day of December, 1938," wherever those words occur in the said notice the words "1st day of April, 1939".
- 4. Except as modified by this notice, the aforesaid notice shall continue in full force and effect.
