## THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (APPLE-JUICE MANUFACTURE) NOTICE 1939.

Pursuant to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, do hereby give notice as follows:—

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Apple-juice Manufacture) Notice 1939.
  - 2. The industry to which this notice relates is the following:—
    The manufacture for sale of apple-juice as herein defined.
- 3. For the purpose of this notice the manufacture of apple-juice shall be deemed to include the manufacture for sale for human consumption from the expressed juice of apples of a beverage which has not undergone alcoholic fermentation sufficient to make it an intoxicating liquor within the meaning of the Licensing Act, 1908.
- 4. On and after such one of the respective dates specified herein as is applicable to the case, the said industry shall be carried on only pursuant to a license issued under Part III of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, and in conformity with the terms and conditions of such license.
- 5. The dates hereinbefore referred to shall be the following, namely:—
  - (a) In the case of any person who on the date of notification hereof in the Gazette is lawfully engaged as a principal in the industry to which the notice relates and who within seven days of the last-mentioned date makes application in writing to the Bureau of Industry for a license, the said date shall be the 1st day of July, 1939:
  - (b) In all other cases the said date shall be the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette*.
