**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (MALT-EXTRACT MANUFACTURE)
NOTICE 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Industries and Commerce, do hereby give notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Malt-extract Manufacture) Notice 1939, Amendment No. 1.

2. This notice shall be read together with and form part of the Industry Licensing (Malt-extract Manufacture) Notice 1939* (hereinafter called the principal notice).

3. The principal notice is amended by substituting for the words "31st day of May, 1940" wherever those words occur the words "31st day of August, 1940".

4. Except as hereby modified, the principal notice shall continue in full force and effect.
