**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (FOOTWEAR MANUFACTURE)  
NOTICE 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Arnold Henry Nordmeyer, Minister of Industries and Commerce, do hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Footwear Manufacture) Notice 1939, Amendment No. 1.

2. This notice shall be read together with and form part of the Industry Licensing (Footwear Manufacture) Notice 1939\* (hereinafter called the principal notice).

3. Clause 2 of the principal notice is amended by revoking the words "for sale."

4. Clause 3 of the principal notice is amended :—

(a) By adding, next after paragraph (e) in the definition of the word "manufacture," the following paragraphs—

"(f) Any such complete or partial process when used in the manufacture of footwear in fulfilment of orders commonly known as 'bespoke' orders; and

"(g) Any such complete or partial processes when used in the manufacture of footwear for gift purposes only, whereby no valuable consideration accrues to the manufacturer thereof."

(b) By revoking the definition of the word "sale."

5. Except as hereby amended, the principal notice shall continue in full force and effect.
