**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (FOOTWEAR-MANUFACTURE)
NOTICE 1939.**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Industries and Commerce, do hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Footwear-manufacture) Notice 1939.

2. The industry to which this notice relates is the following :—
The manufacture for sale of footwear as herein defined.

3. For the purpose of this notice—

“ Manufacture ” means and includes—

(a) Any or all of the processes relating to footwear known respectively as clicking, machining, making, finishing, and cleaning ; and

(b) Every partial process comprised in any of the processes aforesaid ; and

(c) Any other process which may be substituted for or which may replace or modify any of the processes or partial processes aforesaid ; and

(d) Any partial process comprised in any other process which may be substituted for or which may replace or modify any of the processes or partial processes aforesaid ; but “ manufacture ” does not include—

(e) Any such complete or partial process when used in the repair of footwear :

“ Footwear ” includes footwear of whatsoever kind and of whatsoever materials, but does not include footwear commonly known as “ surgical ” :

“ Sale ” does not include disposition by retail for valuable consideration in fulfilment of orders commonly known as “ bespoke ” orders.

4. From such one of the respective dates specified herein as is applicable to the case, the said industry shall be carried on only pursuant to a license issued under Part III of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, and in conformity with the terms and conditions of such license.

5. The dates hereinbefore referred to shall be the following, namely :—

(a) In the case of persons who on the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette* are engaged in the industry to which this notice relates the said date shall be the 30th day of November, 1939, or such earlier or later date (if any) as may hereafter be specified by a further notice under section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, given before the said 30th day of November, 1939 :

(b) In all other cases the said date shall be the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette*.

6. Applications for licenses from persons who are required to obtain licenses to carry on the industry on and after the 1st day of December, 1939, must be lodged with the Bureau of Industry, Wellington, at least two months prior to that date.
