**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (SALT-MANUFACTURE)
NOTICE 1941.**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Salt-manufacture) Notice 1941.

2. The industry to which this notice relates (hereinafter called the said industry) is the following :—

The manufacture for sale of salt as herein defined.

3. For the purpose of this notice :—

(a) "Salt" means common salt (sodium chloride) intended for industrial or domestic use :

(b) "Manufacture" means the preparation of salt from sea-water in any way whereby the water is partly or wholly removed, leaving a residue of pure or impure salt, whether dry, moist, or in solution.

4. From such one of the respective dates specified herein as is applicable to the case, the said industry shall be carried on only pursuant to a license issued under Part III of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, and in conformity with the terms and conditions of such license.

5. The dates hereinbefore referred to shall be the following, namely :—

(a) In the case of persons who on the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette* are engaged in the said industry the said date shall be the 15th day of February 1941, or such earlier or later date (if any) as may hereafter be specified by a further notice under the said section 14 given before the said 15th February, 1941 :

(b) In all other cases the said date shall be the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette*.
