



THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (FISH OIL) NOTICE 1943

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, the Minister of Industries and Commerce hereby gives notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Fish Oil) Notice 1943.

2. The industry to which this notice relates (hereinafter called the said industry) is the following:—

The extraction from fish-livers of nutritional or medicinal oils.

3. For the purposes of this notice “ fish ” includes every description of fish found in New Zealand waters.

4. From such one of the respective dates specified herein as applicable to the case the said industry shall be carried on only pursuant to a license issued under Part III of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, and in conformity with the terms and conditions of such license.

5. The dates hereinbefore referred to shall be the following:—

(a) In the case of persons who on the date of notification hereof in the *Gazette* are engaged in the said industry, the said date shall be the 31st day of July, 1943:

(b) In all other cases the said date shall be the date of notification in the *Gazette*.
