**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (CEMENT-MANUFACTURE)  
REVOCATION NOTICE 1946**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I, Daniel Giles Sullivan, Minister of Industries and Commerce, hereby give notice as follows:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Cement-manufacture) Revocation Notice 1946.
  2. This notice shall come into force on the day following notification hereof in the *Gazette*.
  3. The industry to which this notice relates is the following:—  
Manufacture of cement: Portland and other structural or building cement.
  4. The notice given by me under the said section 14 bearing date the 4th day of December, 1936, and published in the *Gazette* on the 10th day of December, 1936,\* in so far only as it relates to the manufacture of cement: Portland and other structural or building cement, is revoked from the date of coming into force of this notice.
  5. The Industry Licensing (Cement-manufacture) Amendment Notice 1938† is hereby revoked.
  6. Save as hereinbefore provided, the said notice of date the 4th day of December, 1936, shall continue in full force and effect.
