COMMENCEMENT ORDER 1944**

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 1 of the Invercargill Licensing Trust Act, 1944, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as follows:—

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Invercargill Licensing Trust Act Commencement Order 1944.

2. The Invercargill Licensing Trust Act, 1944, shall come into force on the 17th day of April, 1944.
