THE INVERCARGILL LICENSING TRUST (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1950

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Invercargill Licensing Trust Act, 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Invercargill Licensing Trust (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1950.

2. The Invercargill Licensing Trust (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1944* are hereby revoked.

3. (1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949† shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Invercargill Licensing Trust and its members.

(2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day :

Provided that where a member is entitled to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that member.

(3) The mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table :—

Horse-power of Car.	Mileage Allowance.
Not exceeding 9½	5½d. a mile.
Exceeding 9½ but not exceeding 14½	6¼d. a mile.
Over 14½	7d. a mile.

(4) Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred.

4. When any member of the Invercargill Licensing Trust is required in transacting any business of the Trust to travel beyond New Zealand, there shall be paid to him his actual and reasonable locomotion expenses together with a subsistence allowance at such rate as may be fixed by the Minister of Finance.
