**THE INDUSTRY LICENSING (FISH WHOLESALERS)  
NOTICE 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 1.**

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, the Minister of Industries and Commerce doth hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Licensing (Fish Wholesalers) Notice 1939, Amendment No. 1.

2. This notice shall come into force on the 5th day of July, 1940.

3. The Industry Licensing (Fish Wholesalers) Notice 1939\* (hereinafter called the principal notice) is hereby amended by revoking subparagraph (a) of paragraph 3 thereof, and substituting the following :—

“(a) ‘ Fish ’ includes every species of fish and shell-fish found in New Zealand waters except trout, whitebait, and rock-oysters ; and includes such fish, whether fresh, fresh-frozen, or smoked, but does not include such fish when preserved (as distinct from packed only) in cans, jars, or other hermetically sealed containers ”.

4. The principal notice is further amended by adding thereto the following additional paragraph :—

“ 7. Every license issued hereunder prior to the 5th day of July, 1940, shall be deemed to be subject to the condition that the licensee shall not under the authority thereof at any time on or after the 5th day of July, 1940, except with the prior written consent of the Bureau of Industry, carry on the said industry so far as it comprises the sale by wholesale of oysters other than rock-oysters.”

5. Except as modified by this notice, the principal notice shall continue in full force and effect.
