PURSUANT to the Marketing Act 1936 and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Invercargill Milk Treatment Corporation Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Invercargill Milk Treatment Corporation Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Notwithstanding anything in subclause (1) of regulation 5 of the principal regulations, the term of office of directors of the Corporation appointed in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-five shall be two years, but any such director may from time to time be reappointed.
