



THE INDECENT PUBLICATIONS EXEMPTION NOTICE 1954

PURSUANT to the Indecent Publications Act 1910, the Minister of Justice hereby gives notice as follows:

1. This notice may be cited as the Indecent Publications Exemption Notice 1954.

2. The classes of printed matter specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the registration provisions of the Indecent Publications Amendment Act 1954.

3. The classes of printed matter specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the marking provisions of section 10 of the Indecent Publications Amendment Act 1954.
