1 Title

This order is the Injury Prevention, Rehabilitation, and Compensation (Minimum Weekly Earnings) Regulations Revocation Order 2006.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Revocation

The Injury Prevention, Rehabilitation, and Compensation (Minimum Weekly Earnings) Regulations 2004 (SR 2004/188) are revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, revokes the Injury Prevention, Rehabilitation, and Compensation (Minimum Weekly Earnings) Regulations 2004 (the **regulations**).

The amount of minimum weekly earnings for the purposes of weekly compensation formerly determined by the regulations is now automatically adjusted annually by clause 42 of Schedule 1 of the Injury Prevention, Rehabilitation, and Compensation Act 2001.
