

THE IMMIGRATION (PERMITS) REGULATIONS 1979

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of December 1979

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 38 (b) of the Immigration Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Permits) Regulations 1979.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 8th day of January 1980.
- 2. Interpretation—In these regulations "the Act" means the Immigration Act 1964.
- **3.** Forms of entry permits—(1) Every temporary permit granted under section 14 of the Act to any person permitted to enter New Zealand for the purpose of undertaking employment shall be issued in Form 1 in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) Every temporary permit, other than a student's permit, granted under section 14 of the Act to any person permitted to enter New Zealand for any purpose authorised by that section, except the undertaking of employment, shall be issued in Form 2 in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 4. Form of permits to remain temporarily in New Zealand—(1) Every permit granted under section 14B of the Act to any person authorising that person to remain in New Zealand temporarily for the purpose of undertaking employment shall be issued in Form 3 in the Schedule to these regulations.

- (2) Every permit granted under section 14B of the Act to any person authorising that person to remain in New Zealand temporarily for any purpose authorised by section 14 of the Act (as applied by subsection (5) of the said section 14B), except the undertaking of employment, shall be issued in Form 4 in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 5. Form of permit to settle permanently in New Zealand—Every permit granted under section 14 (4) of the Act to any person to whom a temporary permit has been granted and who subsequently intends to settle permanently in New Zealand shall be issued in Form 5 in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 6. Form of entry permit for permanent residence—Every permit granted under section 15 of the Act to any person permitted to enter New Zealand for the purpose of taking up permanent residence in New Zealand shall be issued in Form 6 in the Schedule to these regulations.
- 7. Application of regulations—These regulations shall apply notwith-standing anything in the Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930.
- 8. Revocation—The Immigration (Entry Permits) Regulations 1978* are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The regulations prescribe the form in which work permits, visitors' permits permits authorising the holder to remain in New Zealand temporarily, and permits authorising permanent residence in New Zealand are to be issued.
