

# THE IMMIGRATION REGULATIONS 1987, AMENDMENT NO. 3

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 29th day of January 1990

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 150 of the Immigration Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Immigration Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Immigration Regulations 1987\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1990.
- **2. Fees inclusive of goods and services tax**—Regulation 28 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3), and substituting the following subclause:
- "(3) The fees set out in the Third Schedule to these regulations are inclusive of any goods and services tax payable under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985."
- **3. Fees**—The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Part I, and substituting the Part I set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 February 1990, alter fees payable under the Immigration Regulations 1987. Part of the apparent increase is simply due to the fact that the fees are now set at amounts that are inclusive of goods and services tax. Some fees remain the same. Others are increased or reduced. For example, the fee for a returning resident's visa remains unchanged at \$22.50 but the fee for a residence visa requiring commercial assessment under regulation 4 (3) is increased from \$900 to \$1,800.
