



**THE IMMIGRATION REGULATIONS 1987, AMENDMENT NO. 4**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 1st day of July 1991

Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 150 of the Immigration Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Immigration Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Immigration Regulations 1987\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 8th day of July 1991.

**2. Fees**—(1) The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Part I (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Immigration Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the Part I set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Part II of the Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting from clause 1 (1)—

- (a) The expression "any of clauses 1 to 3 of"; and  
 (b) The expression "of clause 1".

**3. Revocation**—The Immigration Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 3 are hereby consequentially amended by revoking regulation 3 and the Schedule.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 8 July 1991,—

- (a) Impose new fees of \$50 for applications for visitors' visas and \$510 for appeals to the Minister to cancel a removal warrant on humanitarian grounds under section 63 of the Act:
- (b) Remove the distinction between application fees and issuing fees for residence visas and for residence permits applied for in New Zealand:
- (c) Increase other fees prescribed under the Act as follows:
  - (i) The application fee for a residence visa or for a residence permit applied for in New Zealand, being applications requiring commercial assessment, is increased from \$1,800 to \$2,255 (but there is now no \$148.50 fee payable on issue of the visa or permit):
  - (ii) The application fee for residence visas and residence permits not requiring commercial assessment is increased from \$306 to \$618 (but again there is no longer a fee payable on issue of the visa or permit):
  - (iii) The application fee for returning residents' visas is increased from \$22.50 to \$50:
  - (iv) The application fee for a student visa is increased from \$171 to \$188:
  - (v) The application fee for a student permit applied for in New Zealand is increased from \$63 to \$70:
  - (vi) The application fee for work visas and work permits applied for in New Zealand is increased from \$117 to \$128:
  - (vii) The application fee for a visitor permit applied for in New Zealand is increased from \$45 to \$50:
  - (viii) The application fee for a reconsideration under section 31 of the Act, or for a special direction, is increased from \$112.50 to \$124.00.
