

## THE IMMIGRATION REGULATIONS 1991, AMENDMENT NO. 7

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 26th day of August 1996

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 150 of the Immigration Act 1987, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Immigration Regulations 1991, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Immigration Regulations 1991\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1996.
- 2. Persons exempt from requirement to obtain temporary visa— Part 1 of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended—

# EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1996, extend the exemption from the requirement to obtain a temporary visa to citizens of the Czech Republic and the Republic of South Africa, where the permit sought is a visitor permit for no longer than 3 months.
