PURSUANT to section 1 (2) of the Industrial Relations Amendment Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Industrial Relations Amendment Act Commencement Order 1978.

**2. Commencement of Act**—The Industrial Relations Amendment Act 1977 (except section 9 which came into force on the 21st day of December 1977) shall come into force on the 17th day of April 1978.
