**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 125 of the Industrial Relations Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Industrial Relations (Essential Industries) Order 1974.

**2. Essential industries**—The First Schedule to the Industrial Relations Act 1973 is hereby amended by adding the following clauses:

“11. The provision of pilotage services at any port.

“12. The provision of all necessary services in connection with the arrival, berthing, and departure of ships at any port.”
