**THE INDUSTRY REGISTRATION (STORAGE-BATTERY
MANUFACTURE) NOTICE 1938.**

WHEREAS pursuant to the authority conferred on me by section 13 of the Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936, I have directed the Bureau of Industry to compile and maintain registers in connection with the industry hereinafter mentioned, now, therefore, I hereby give notice as follows :—

1. This notice may be cited as the Industry Registration (Storage-battery Manufacture) Notice 1938.

2. The industry to which this notice relates is the following :—

The manufacture and/or assembly of secondary or storage cells and batteries, commonly known as wet batteries, or any part or parts thereof.

3. All persons who were engaged as principals in the industry to which this notice relates on the 19th day of May, 1938, shall, on or before the 7th day of July, 1938, furnish to the Secretary of the Bureau of Industry at Wellington the particulars indicated in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.

4. The prescribed form shall be signed, in the case of a business carried on by an individual or partnership firm, by such individual or by a member of such firm, and, in the case of a business carried on by an incorporated company, by a director, manager, secretary, or other responsible officer thereof.
