ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of
July, 1948

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 44 of the Immigration Restriction Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930, Amendment No. 5.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. Regulation 18 of the principal regulations, as substituted by the Immigration Restriction Regulations 1930, Amendment No. 2†, is amended by adding thereto the following clause :—

“(10) Notwithstanding anything hereinbefore contained, no certificate of registration shall be granted by a Collector of Customs in any case where the Minister, at his discretion, has directed that a certificate of registration be not granted.”
