ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of January 1963

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Intermediate Schools and Departments Regulations 1932, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations for Intermediate Schools and Departments made by Order in Council dated the 15th day of December 1932* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1963.

2. Regulation 21 of the principal regulations, as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

"(1) For the management of each intermediate school not forming a department of a secondary, technical, or combined school, there shall be a committee consisting of nine members elected biennially by the parents or guardians of the pupils attending the intermediate school:

"Provided that the Minister may modify the constitution of the Committee as he considers necessary."
