ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of December 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Incorporated Societies Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Incorporated Societies Regulations 1979, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Incorporated Societies Regulations 1979* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the

date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Form of declaration of non-disclosure—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 9, the following regulation:

"9A. Every declaration made under section 34A (2) of the Act shall be in

the form set out in the Third Schedule to these regulations."

(2) The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding, after the Second Schedule, the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

DECLARATION OF NON-DISCLOSURE UNDER SECTION 34A (2) OF THE INCORPORATED SOCIETIES ACT 1908

I, [Insert name], of [Insert place of abode and occupation], solemnly and sincerely declare—

- 1. That the Registrar of Incorporated Societies has authorised me to exercise the powers specified in subsection (1) of section 34A of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 in relation to the society or societies named in the Schedule hereto and for all or any of the purposes specified in that subsection.
- 2. That I will not, except in accordance with section 34A (3) of that Act or for the purposes of that Act or in the course of any criminal proceedings, make a record of or divulge or communicate to any other person any information that I acquire by an inspection under subsection (1) of the said section 34A.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations specify the form of declaration of non-disclosure pursuant to section 34A of the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 (as inserted by section 5 of the Incorporated Societies Amendment Act 1981).
