### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of November 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 5 (1) of the Industrial Training Levies Act 1978, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Industrial Training Levies Order 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. General basis of levies**—Any levy imposed under section 4 of the Industrial Training Levies Act 1978 shall be imposed on the general basis set out in the Schedule to this order.

Number of employees employed in each factory	Maximum rate of levy
2-10	\$ 25
11-20	50
21-50	125
51-100	250
101-200	500
More than 200	1,250
