**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of December 1981

PURSUANT to section 5 (1) of the Industrial Training Levies Act 1978, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Industrial Training Levies Order 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Industrial Training Levies Order 1978\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. General basis of levies**—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the expression “25”, and substituting the expression “30”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order makes one alteration to the general basis on which levies may be imposed under the Industrial Training Levies Act 1978. In the case of a factory where 2 to 10 employees are employed, the maximum rate of annual levy is increased from \$25 to \$30. In every other case the maximum rate of levy is unchanged.
