THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 5 (1) of the Industrial Training Levies Act 1978, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Industrial Training Levies Order 1982.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. General basis of levies—Any levy imposed under section 4 of the Industrial Training Levies Act 1978 shall be imposed on the general basis set out in the Schedule to this order.
- 3. Revocations—The Industrial Training Levies Order 1978\* and the Industrial Training Levies Order 1978, Amendment No. 1† are hereby revoked.
