HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 86D of the Income Tax Act 1976, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Income Tax (Average Market Values of Specified Livestock) Order 1988.
- **2. Application**—This order shall apply with respect to specified livestock on hand at the end of the income year that commenced on the 1st day of April 1987.
- **3.** Average market values of specified livestock—For the purposes of section 86D of the Income Tax Act 1976, it is hereby declared that the average market values of certain specified livestock are those set out in the Schedule to this order.
