ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 14E (2) and 150 of the Immigration Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Transit Visas—Extension) Regulations 1995.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 30th day of June 1995.

**2. Extension of application of Immigration (Transit Visas) Regulations 1994**—(1) The application of the Immigration (Transit Visas) Regulations 1994 is hereby extended until the close of the 30th day of June 1996.

(2) Regulation 2 of those regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the expression “30th day of June 1995”, and substituting the expression “30th day of June 1996”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
