PURSUANT to subsection (5) of section 4 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1977 and to subsection (5) of section 61A of the Judicature Act 1908 (as inserted by section 8 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1977), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Judicature Amendment Act Commencement Order 1977.

2. Commencement of section 4 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1977—Section 4 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1977 shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1978.

3. Commencement of section 61A of the Judicature Amendment Act 1908—Section 61A of the Judicature Act 1908 (as inserted by section 8 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1977) shall have effect from the 31st day of January 1978.
