**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Judicature Amendment Act Commencement Order 1977.

**2. Commencement of section 4 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1977**—Section 4 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1977 shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1978.

**3. Commencement of section 61A of the Judicature Amendment Act 1908**—Section 61A of the Judicature Act 1908 (as inserted by section 8 of the Judicature Amendment Act 1977) shall have effect from the 31st day of January 1978.
