ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Judicial and Other Statutory Salaries Order 1971.

2. Salaries of Judges, Magistrates, Ombudsman, and Controller and Auditor-General—The scales of salaries payable to Judges of the Court of Appeal, Judges of the Supreme Court, the Judge and any additional Judge of the Court of Arbitration, the Judge of the Compensation
