ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Judicial and other Statutory Salaries Order (No. 3) 1976.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 15th day of May 1977.
- 2. Salaries of Judges, Magistrates, Ombudsmen, and Controller and Auditor-General—The scales of salaries payable to Judges of the Court of Appeal, Judges of the Supreme Court, the Judge of the Industrial Court (not being a temporary Judge), the Judge of the Compensation Court, Judges of the Maori Land Court, Magistrates, Ombudsmen, and the Controller and Auditor-General shall be those set out in the Schedule to this order.
- 3. Revocation—The Judicial and Other Statutory Salaries Order (No. 2) 1976* is hereby revoked.
