### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of June 1982

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 16 (5) of the Joint Family Homes Act 1964 (as added by section 9 (2) of the Joint Family Homes Amendment Act 1974), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

---

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Joint Family Homes (Specified Sum) Order 1982.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 12th day of July 1982.

**2. Increase in amount protected against creditors**—For the purposes of the Joint Family Homes Act 1964, the specified sum mentioned in section 16 (5) of that Act is hereby prescribed as being \$21,500.

**3. Revocation**—The Joint Family Homes (Specified Sum) Order 1978\* is hereby consequentially revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order increases, from \$15,000 to \$21,500, the amount up to which a person's interest in a joint family home is generally protected against creditors.
