ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of June 1982

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 16 (5) of the Joint Family Homes Act 1964 (as added by section 9 (2) of the Joint Family Homes Amendment Act 1974), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Joint Family Homes (Specified Sum) Order 1982.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 12th day of July 1982.
- 2. Increase in amount protected against creditors—For the purposes of the Joint Family Homes Act 1964, the specified sum mentioned in section 16 (5) of that Act is hereby prescribed as being \$21,500.
- **3. Revocation**—The Joint Family Homes (Specified Sum) Order 1978* is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases, from \$15,000 to \$21,500, the amount up to which a person's interest in a joint family home is generally protected against creditors.
