ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Jury Fees Order 1969.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1969.

2. Jury fees—The jury fees payable under sections 159 and 160 of the Juries Act 1908 shall be the following amounts:

For a special jury	 	 54.00
