PURSUANT to the Juries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. **Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Jury Fees Order 1969.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1969.

2. **Jury fees**—The jury fees payable under sections 159 and 160 of the Juries Act 1908 shall be the following amounts:
