PURSUANT to the Juries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Jury Fees Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1974.

2. Jury fees—The jury fees payable under sections 159 and 160 of the Juries Act 1908, for every day or part of a day on which the jury serves, shall be the following amounts:

For a common jury of four	36.00
For a special jury	108.00
