PURSUANT to section 35 of the Juries Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice of the Minister of Justice tendered after consultation with the Chief Justice, the Chief District Court Judge, and the President of the New Zealand Law Society, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

1. Title and commencement—(1) These rules may be cited as the Jury Rules 1982, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Jury Rules 1982* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).

(2) These rules shall come into force on the 13th day of March 1989.

2. Fee for jury in civil cases—The principal rules are hereby amended by revoking rule 24 (as substituted by rule 2 of the Jury Rules 1982, Amendment No. 5), and substituting the following rule:

“24. The fee payable in a civil case under section 31 of the Act for every day or part of a day on which the jury serves shall be as follows:

“(a) For the first day or part of a day	700.00
“(b) For each subsequent day or part of a day	350.00.”

3. Fees inclusive of goods and services tax—The fees fixed by these rules are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

4. Revocation—Rule 2 of the Jury Rules 1982, Amendment No. 5 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the rules, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These rules, which come into force on 13 March 1989, increase the fees payable under section 31 of the Juries Act 1981 by a party who requires a jury in civil proceedings.
