PURSUANT to section 35 of the Juries Act 1981, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice of the Minister of Justice tendered after consultation with the Chief Justice, the Chief District Court Judge, and the President of the New Zealand Law Society, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

1. Title and commencement—(1) These rules may be cited as the Jury Rules 1990, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Jury Rules 1990* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).

(2) These rules shall come into force on the 8th day of October 1991.

2. Fee for jury in civil cases—The principal rules are hereby amended by revoking rule 26 and substituting the following rule:

“26. The fee payable in a civil case under section 31 of the Act for every day or part of a day on which the jury serves shall be as follows:

“(a) For the first day or part of a day	800.00
“(b) For each subsequent day or part of a day		..	400.00.”
