THE JUDICIAL SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES DETERMINATION (NO. 8) 1987

PURSUANT to section 290 of the Labour Relations Act 1987 and section 12B (1) (c) of the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977 (as amended by section 359 (f) of the Labour Relations Act 1987), and after having regard to section 2 (2) of the Higher Salaries Commission Amendment Act 1987, the Commission hereby makes the following determination.

DETERMINATION

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Judicial Salaries and Allowances Determination (No. 3) 1987.
- (2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.
- **2. Salaries and allowances of Judges of Labour Court**—The salaries payable to the Judges of the Labour Court and the allowances for general expenses payable to those Judges shall be paid at the following rates:
