# THE JURY SERVICE EXEMPTION ORDER 1965

Pursuant to the Juries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Jury Service Exemption Order 1965.
- 2. A person shall be exempt from serving on any jury if he or she is one of the following:
  - (a) A member of a Board of Review established under the Inland Revenue Department Amendment Act 1960:
  - (b) An employee of the Public Service who is employed in the Police Department.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect. This order exempts members of taxation Boards of Review and civilian employees of the Police Department from jury service. These exemptions are additional to those already specified in section 6 of the Juries Act 1908.
