**THE JURY SERVICE EXEMPTION ORDER 1965**

PURSUANT to the Juries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

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**ORDER**

1. This order may be cited as the Jury Service Exemption Order 1965.
2. A person shall be exempt from serving on any jury if he or she is one of the following:
  - (a) A member of a Board of Review established under the Inland Revenue Department Amendment Act 1960:
  - (b) An employee of the Public Service who is employed in the Police Department.

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**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order exempts members of taxation Boards of Review and civilian employees of the Police Department from jury service. These exemptions are additional to those already specified in section 6 of the Juries Act 1908.
