Pursuant to the Juries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Jury Service Exemption Order 1966.
- 2. A person shall be exempt from serving on any jury if he or she holds office under the Civil Defence Act 1962 or the State Services Act 1962 as one of the following:
  - (a) The Director of Civil Defence:
  - (b) The Deputy Director of Civil Defence:
  - (c) A Regional Commissioner of Civil Defence:
  - (d) The Deputy of a Regional Commissioner of Civil Defence:
  - (e) An Assistant Regional Commissioner of Civil Defence.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order exempts the principal officers of the Civil Defence organisation from jury service.
