- (e) In relation to Magistrates, to the Magistrates' Courts Act 1947,—His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Judicial Salaries Order 1978.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 13th day of October 1977.

2. Salaries of Judges and Magistrates—The salaries payable to Judges of the Court of Appeal, Judges of the Supreme Court, the Judge of the Industrial Court (not being a temporary Judge), the Judge of the Compensation Court, Judges of the Maori Land Court, and Magistrates shall be paid at the respective rates set out in the Schedule to this order.

3. Revocation—The Judicial and Other Statutory Salaries Order 1977* is hereby revoked.
