At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 29th day of January 1979

PURSUANT to the Industrial Relations Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Judicial Salaries Order 1979.
 (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the
- 17th day of April 1978.
- 2. Salaries of Judges of the Arbitration Court—(1) The salary payable to each Judge of the Arbitration Court (other than the Chief Judge or a temporary Judge) shall—

 (a) In respect of the period commencing on the 17th day of April
 - 1978 and ending with the close of the 16th day of July 1978, be paid at the rate of \$38,000 a year; and
 - (b) On and after the 17th day of July 1978, be paid at the rate of \$38,365 a year.
- (2) The Judicial Salaries Order (No. 2) 1978* is hereby consequentially amended by revoking subclause (2) of clause 3.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which is deemed to have come into force on 17 April 1978, increases the salaries of the Judges of the Arbitration Court (other than the Chief Judge). The salaries of those Judges were fixed at \$35,000 a year by the Judicial Salaries Order (No. 2) 1978. That order implemented recommendations of the Higher Salaries Commission.

This order now fixes the salaries of those Judges at \$38,000 a year as at 17 April 1978. This new figure has been recommended by the Higher Salaries Commission.

The incorporation of the amount of the general wage order on 17 July 1978 increases the figure to \$38,365.

The salary of the Chief Judge of the Arbitration Court (at present \$42,865 a year) is not affected.
